What's New?

Downtown Los Angeles service – We have extended the Silver Streak route to the Pico and Flower Station in downtown Los Angeles to improve connections with the Metro Rail. We have also added an additional Line 495 trip in the afternoon, which leaves downtown Los Angeles at 2:33 p.m.

Route adjustments – We have adjusted the route for Line 292, which now includes a new bus stop in front of Pomona High School. Line 274 will return to its regular route along Puente Ave., between Don Julian and Temple. Line 281 will return to its regular route along Citrus St., between the I-10 Freeway and Cameron. Commuter Express Lines 493, 495, 497, 498, 499, and 699 will return to their regular route along Hope St. and Flower St., between 1st St. and 6th St.

Transferring to other agencies – Beginning, Sunday, July 15th, transferring to other transit agencies will require a TAP card. Transfers will be automatic and the transfer fare will be deducted from your TAP card on the second bus or rail that you board. In addition, the transfer period will extend to two and a half hours after first boarding. You will need stored value on the card. For more info, visit foothilltransit.org/tap.
